NUHS Fund supports research, education, and patient programmes to fulfil NUHS' vision of shaping medicine to transform care for a healthy Singapore community.

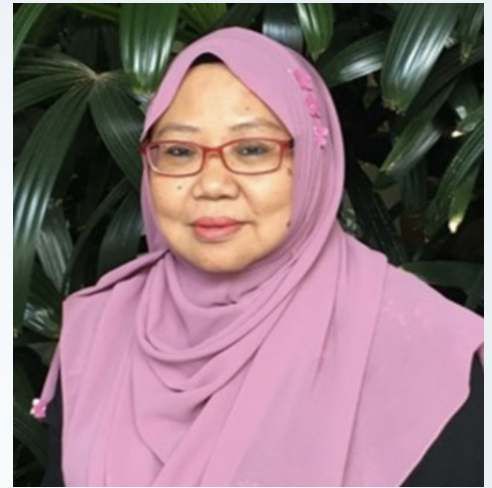

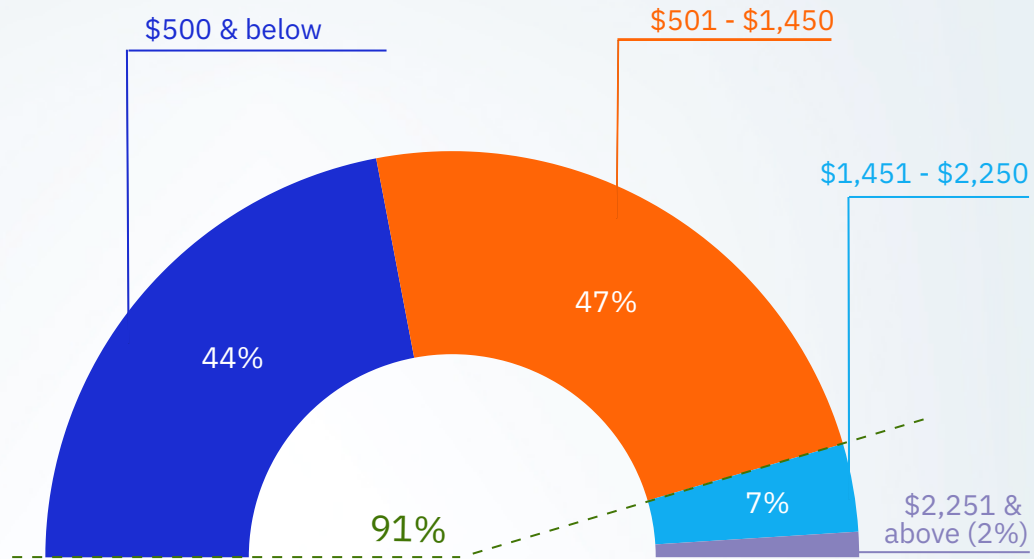

Thanks to your generosity, Destinee's father was relieved of the financial burden related to her medical expenses, allowing him to focus on her wellbeing.

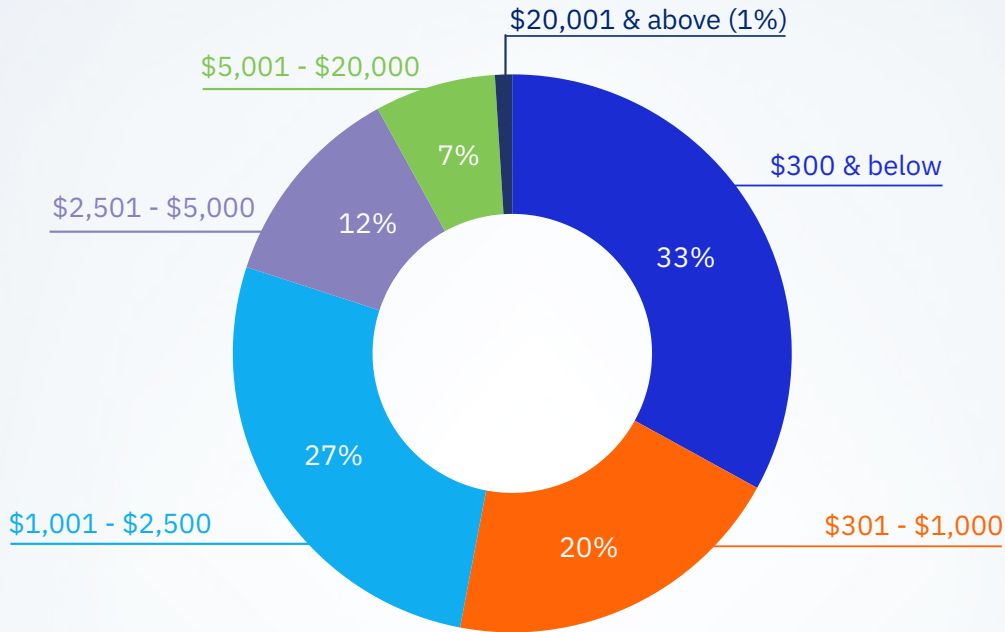

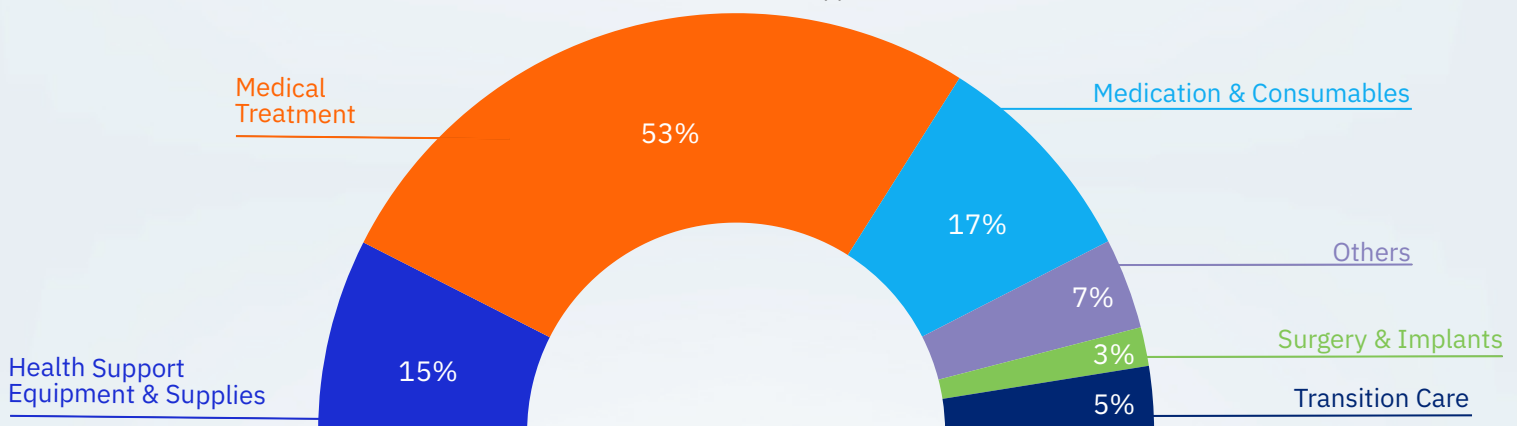

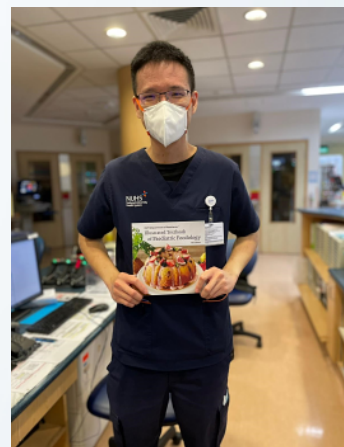
