
Support is given to Singaporeans and Permanent Residents for costs not supported by other assistance schemes.

Your Gift Matters!

Over the past two years, Mdm Riah, 45 years old, faced significant health challenges, having been diagnosed with both ovarian and thyroid cancer. She had undergone multiple surgeries for these conditions and is currently undergoing chemotherapy.

As a homemaker, Mdm Riah cares for her husband, two children, her father and grandmother. With her medical conditions, it is increasingly difficult for her to perform her usual tasks, such as taking her father and grandmother to medical appointments and cooking for her family.

Chemotherapy has taken a huge toll on her, leaving her fatigued. Financially, the cost of chemotherapy was also a heavy burden on the family as her husband's sole income is only enough to cover basic expenses.


With the help of a medical social worker, Mdm Riah was able to receive financial aid from the NUHS Fund, which has provided a lifeline for her. This crucial financial relief has enabled her to focus on her recovery and gradually resume her caregiving responsibilities.

Funding amount is decided based on financial assessment by Medical Social workers.




BY CONDITION

Qiaochu, 29 years old, has Neuromyelitis Optica, a rare autoimmune disorder that affects her vision and spinal cord. Due to her condition, Qiaochu is unable to find a stable job and her family relies on her father's sole income as a cleaner.

When she contracted COVID in 2023, Qiaochu was hospitalised for close to 3 months due to complications. During this trying period, Qiaochu and her family experienced financial stress from the mounting hospitalisation bill as they have limited personal savings.

With the help of the NUHS Fund and generous donors, Qiaochu received financial aid to settle her outstanding hospitalisation bills so that she could focus on her recovery. She has gradually regained her health and continues to look for employment to help support her family.
