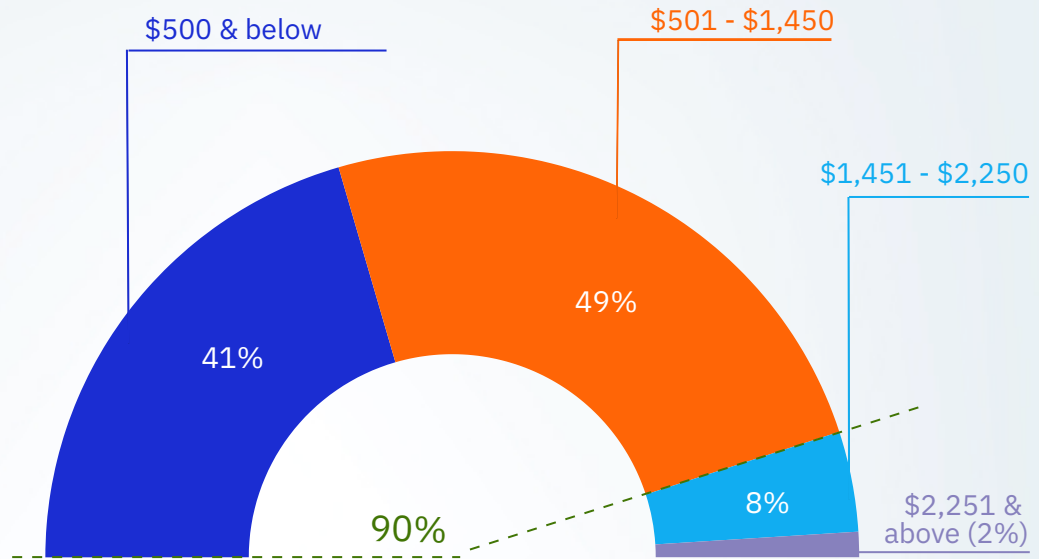
Support is given to Singaporeans and Permanent Residents for costs not supported by other assistance schemes.

Thanks to your generosity, Jie Rong's parents received much-needed assistance with his medical expenses, allowing them to focus on his wellbeing.

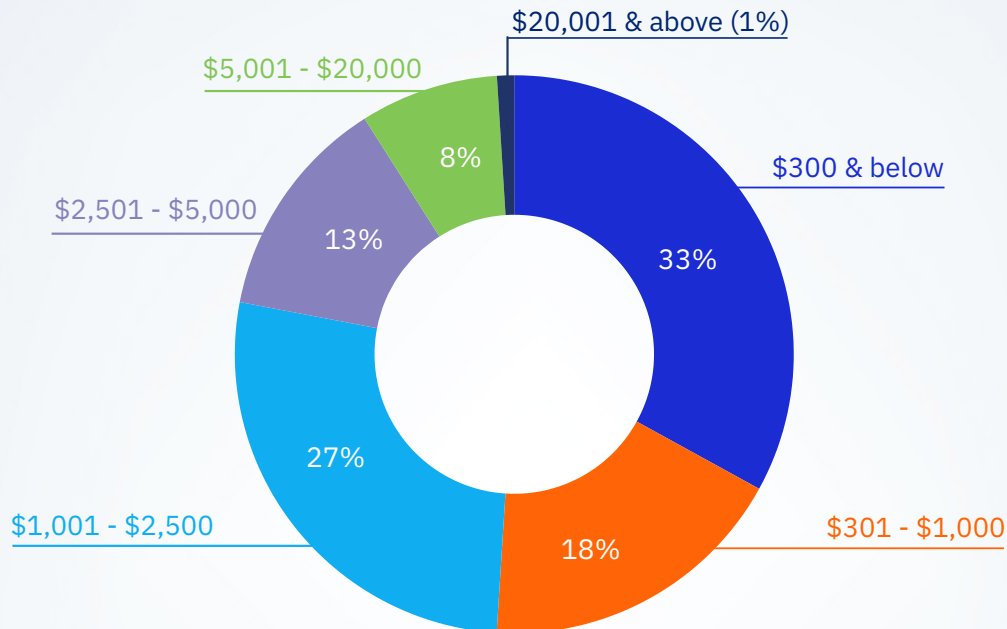

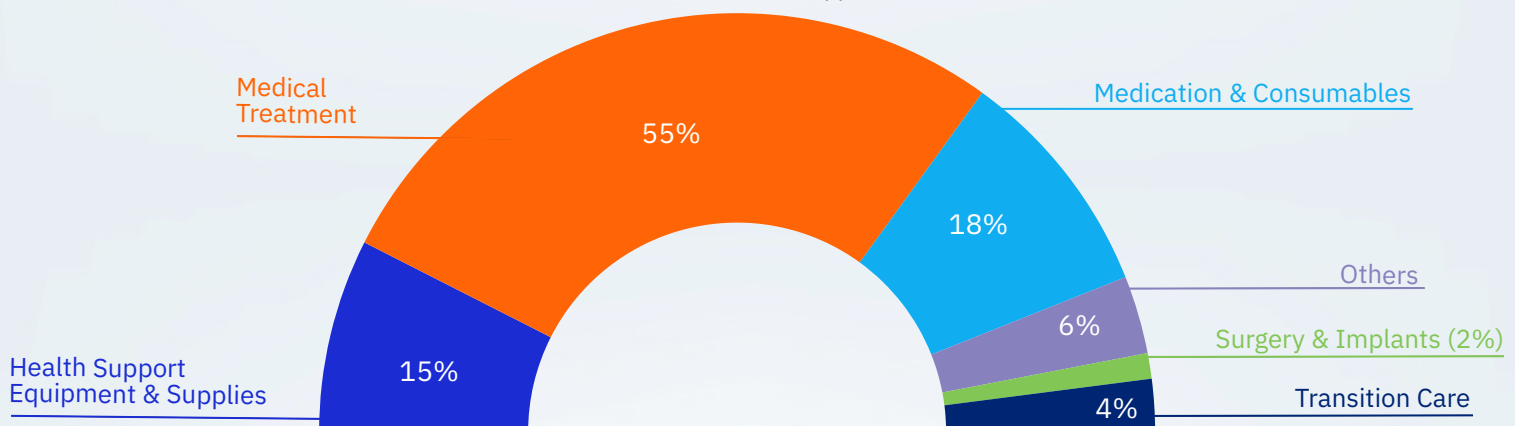

Your generous support has given Mdm Wong much-needed financial relief, allowing her to fully focus on receiving timely treatment.

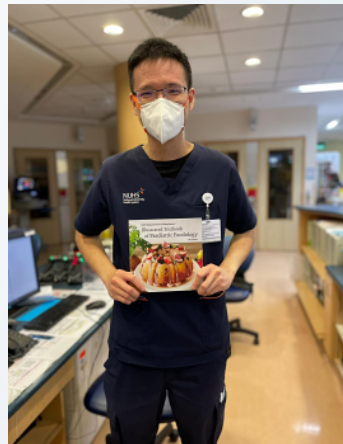
