| TEAM AWARD

This award celebrates the synergy, teamwork and dedication exhibited by a team in delivering a clinical quality/practice improvement project which significantly contributed to bridging the gap between knowledge and practice, with a strong research element in knowledge translation process

resulting in improved standard of care, health outcomes, higher efficiency and/or more effective patient-centred services.

The team should demonstrate their achievements through successful implementation of the project, which is novel and beneficial to patients.

Bringing cancer care closer to home, NCIS on-the-go (NOTG) has expanded access to low-risk cancer treatments and supportive therapies in the community, reducing patient travel and waiting times while increasing treatment capacity at the main cancer centre by 11.2%.



The NOTG programme has expanded from routine blood tests to 19 low-risk treatments across three satellite clinics within 20 km of the main hospital. Patient visits surged nearly tenfold, from 1,081 in 2017 to over 10,285 in 2023, with unique patients increasing from 406 to 1,905. By decanting 11.2% of the main cancer centre's workload, with plans to reach 15-20%, NOTG has optimised healthcare resources and reduced congestion.

Its success is driven by oncology-trained nurses

independently managing procedures in the community, robust patient selection protocols, and a streamlined courier system for medication transport. Transitioning to a default enrolment model for eligible treatments has further extended NOTG's reach and impact.

With a 96.8% satisfaction rate, NOTG has reduced travel time for 45.8% of patients by 10-30 minutes, lowered costs for 51.6% by S\$5-20+ per visit, and shortened waiting times for nearly 30%. Crucially, it

maintains safety standards comparable to hospital-based care.

Aligning with Singapore's 'Beyond Hospital to Community' strategy, NOTG has gained national media recognition and international acclaim, featuring in ESMO Open as a model for global cancer care delivery. By enhancing accessibility, efficiency, and patient-centred care, NOTG is setting a new benchmark for community-based oncology services.

The NUHS App serves as the digital front door to NUHS services, empowering patients and enhancing their healthcare experience. Developed over the past four years, the app has amassed over 1.3 million downloads and 25,000 daily users, streamlining access to healthcare with a seamless phygital experience. The app fosters self-service, personalised care, and teleconsultation, resulting in a reduction of 56 full-time frontline counter staffing and improving patient engagement.



The NUHS App team has collaborated across multiple disciplines to integrate technology into healthcare, enhancing patient journeys and streamlining business processes. Through features such as real-time Live Chat support, end-to-end TeleConsult services and EPIC MyChart's personalised care plans, the app has enabled 76% of NUHS patients to manage their healthcare needs independently. This shift towards self-service

digital processes has improved patient satisfaction, reduced waiting times, and allowed staff to focus on high-value care roles, such as care coordination, further elevating the quality of healthcare delivery. Beyond patient care, the app also supports community outreach, research recruitment, and national initiatives such as Healthier SG.

Globally recognised for digital health innovation, the NUHS App

team received the OpenGov Asia Recognition of Excellence Award 2023 and was featured at the Healthcare Information and Management Systems Society (HIMSS) Global Conference 2024 in Orlando, USA, and the International Hospital Federation (IHF) 2024 Innovation Hub Awards in Brazil, cementing NUHS as a leader in digital health transformation.

NUHS@Home redefines inpatient care by providing hospital-level treatment to patients in the comfort of their own homes. Since its launch in 2020, the programme has treated over 2,600 patients, saved more than 15,000 bed days, and consistently maintained highest bed occupancy rate among the Mobile Inpatient Care @ Home (MIC@Home) programmes of Singapore's healthcare clusters.



Under NUHS@Home, a dedicated multi-disciplinary team, including doctors, nurses, pharmacists, and allied health professionals, collaborates seamlessly to deliver comprehensive, patient-centred care. Through integrated virtual consultations, remote monitoring, and home visits, NUHS@Home ensures timely intervention and continuity of care. By leveraging technology-driven efficiencies, such as automated alerts, teleconsultations and

chatbot-enabled monitoring, it has allowed them to scale operations effectively with more efficient workflows.

The success of NUHS@Home is driven by the synergy of its team, whose collaborative efforts have expanded the range of conditions treatable at home, from cellulitis to post-bariatric surgery. The introduction of advanced medical devices, such as the

Continuous Ambulatory Delivery Device (CADD) pump, has optimised care for complex patients, reducing hospitalisations and staff visits. With consistent positive patient feedback and outcomes, the programme's influence extends beyond Singapore, contributing to national policy discussions and sharing insights internationally, further showcasing the potential of hospital-at-home models.

PaedsENGAGE, is revolutionising paediatric healthcare in Singapore. Since its launch in April 2023, the programme has built a robust nationwide network, engaging 508 General Practitioners (GPs) from 398 clinics. This initiative aims to ensure children receive appropriate care closer to home, reducing unnecessary Emergency visits and improving primary care accessibility. In the NUH Western cluster alone, 128 GPs from 91 clinics have been recruited within 1.5 years, forming a vital support network for families.



The programme's success is rooted in its three-pronged approach: engagement, education, and empowerment. PaedsENGAGE fosters strong GP partnerships through co-creation and continuous feedback. Educational initiatives include a comprehensive eight-part e-learning module, clinical attachments at Children's Emergency, and quarterly GP Educational Forums. A dedicated WhatsApp Q&A community enhances real-time support and peer collaboration, addressing knowledge gaps identified through GP focus groups.

The impact of PaedsENGAGE is evident in its outcomes. The programme has reduced self-referred Children's Emergency visits by 2.2% in FY24, aligning with MOH's annual 3% reduction target. Moreover, 99.1% of GP referrals met appropriateness criteria, ensuring efficient resource utilisation. Extensive public outreach via social media, national TV, and newspapers has successfully shifted health-seeking behaviours towards primary care, encouraging parents to consult GPs for mild-to-moderate conditions.





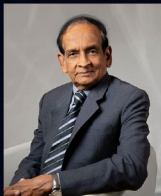
